## Bricks Bricks Bricks!

#### Rugby League Works Progress

Works are progressing well with the installation of the breezeway ceiling, completion of the remaining aluminium, and ongoing internal and existing-building brickwork.

Wall sheeting, capping, and flashings work has continued, alongside mechanical works and coordinated plumbing and electrical activities to support the bricklayers.

Electrical and mechanical works within the kitchen area also progressing.

Over the new two weeks, brickwork will continue across both the new and existing buildings, supported by the installation of window framing, electrical and plumbing.

The next phase of the project will see roofing works commencing shortly.



## Structural Steel Complete at AFL and Little Athletics Pavillion

Progress continues as the installation of structural steel is finalised. In-ground hydraulics, and grouting beneath the newly installed steel elements has been completed.

Over the next two weeks, works will continue with further structural steel installation, ongoing steel framing, and the continuation of plumbing activities, including potable water and sewer pipework.
